

**Resolution authorizing supplemental appropriations in the Selective Enforcement Fund for the High Visibility Enforcement Grant. (Sheriff)**

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office received a High Visibility Enforcement Grant from the State of Ohio in the amount of \$87,556.56 to reimburse the Sheriff’s Office for the cost of overtime; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant will allow the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office to conduct high visibility traffic enforcement in locations and times that will allow for the greatest impact in reducing serious and fatal injury crashes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office has indicated that non-general fund supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$37,599.91 are needed for continued support of this grant; now, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$37,599.91 are hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #1768):
