

**Establishing, altering and widening of Snouffer Road at Snouffer Place and Bride Water Boulevard, the City of Columbus, Perry Township, Franklin County, Ohio, declared necessary (Engineer)**

**WHEREAS**, Perry Township has expressed a need to construct a crosswalk on Snouffer Road at Snouffer Place and Bride Water Boulevard, near the Brookside Elementary School in Perry Township, Franklin County Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, Perry Township has requested that the Franklin County Engineer act on its behalf to complete the project; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 5553.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, provided that when the Board of County Commissioners is of the opinion that it will be necessary for public convenience and welfare to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten, vacate or change the direction of a public road, it shall so declare by resolution; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That it is necessary for public convenience and welfare that proceedings be initiated to construct a crosswalk on Snouffer Road at Snouffer Place and Bride Water Boulevard, near the Brookside Elementary School in Perry Township, Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2) That the Franklin County Engineer, by his request, is hereby authorized to enter agreements as necessary to complete the Brookside Elementary Safe Routes to School Project.

Section 3) That the cost of this project shall be reimbursed to Franklin County by Perry Township and/or Safe Routes to School funding through the Ohio Department of Transportation.
