

Resolution authorizing settlement of a claim for damages to Franklin County property located at 280 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio.

(Public Facilities Management)

(\$8,648.73)

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2014, a vehicle entered the Memorial Hall surface parking lot, located at 280 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, a property owned by the Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the driver failed to control her vehicle and damaged the exterior façade of Memorial Hall; and

WHEREAS, this action would authorize acceptance of payment by United Services Automobile Association to Franklin County in the amount of Eight Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars and Seventy-Three Cents (\$8,648.73) as reimbursement of the costs associated with repair of the exterior façade of Memorial Hall; and

WHEREAS, the settlement, recommended by Franklin County Public Facilities Management and the Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney deem it to be in the best interest of the Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio to settle the claim for Eight Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars and Seventy-Three Cents (\$8,648.73); now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

That the above referenced settlement in the amount of \$8,648.73 is in the best interest of the Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio and Public Facilities Management and the same is hereby approved.
