

Resolution reconfirming Franklin County's commitment to continue development of existing projects funded with Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission-attributable federal funding, and endorsing the new projects recently submitted for funding consideration (Engineer)

WHEREAS, the Surface Transportation Program, the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program and Transportation Alternative Program, all administered by the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission, provide federal-aid assistance for repair and replacement of local infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission conducts a biannual update of its Transportation Improvement Plan and requires local agencies to reconfirm both their commitment to existing projects funded with MORPC funds as well as those submitted for future funding consideration; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has general charge of the construction, reconstruction, improvement, maintenance and repair of all bridges and roads under the jurisdiction of the Board of County Commissioners; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That Franklin County is committed to continue developing projects currently programmed with MORPC funds, including: Hamilton Road from Clark State Road to US62 and Harrisburg Pike Sidewalks from Eakin Road-Hopkins Avenue to Brown Road.

Section 2) That Franklin County will commit to developing projects currently being considered for MORPC funds: Frank Road from Harrisburg Pike to I-71 ramps, Pontius Road from London & Lancaster Road to Rohr Road and Winchester Pike from Shannon Road-Ebright Road to Bixby Road-Brice Road.

Section 3) That Franklin County agrees to fund the local share cost of the proposed projects, as designated in the attached Summary of MORPC Federal-Aid Application Resolution dated September 9, 2014, from the Engineer's Auto and Gas Tax Fund (2015)
