

Resolution authorizing supplemental appropriations for social service contracts and home repairs in the Senior Services Fund. (Office on Aging)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office on Aging has experienced a 7.5% increase in enrollment in the programs provided to support Franklin County seniors; and

WHEREAS, several contracts with the providers of products and services included in these programs will be renewed in October 2014 resulting in price increases between 1% and 1.5%; and

WHEREAS, the Office on Aging projects that expenditures will exceed the current 2014 allocations due to increased demand for products and services including homecare, home repair, transportation, and adult nutritional; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office on Aging has requested supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$1.5 million in the Senior Services Fund to meet this increased demand; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$1,500,000 is hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #875):
