

Resolution authorizing the Franklin County Engineer to enter into an agreement with the City of Beavercreek for the purchase of highway rock salt (Engineer)

WHEREAS, highway rock salt is an essential material necessary for maintaining a safe roadway surface during the winter months in Ohio after a moderate snow fall; and

WHEREAS, the unusually severe weather conditions experienced during the 2013-2014 winter season created a high demand for highway rock salt that has led to limited supplies and higher costs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Beavercreek has acquired a large quantity of highway rock salt under a Southwest Ohio Purchasers for Government (SWOP4G) contract at a competitive cost; and

WHEREAS, the City of Beavercreek has agreed to sell a portion of the highway rock salt they purchased to Franklin County; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That the Franklin County Engineer is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Beavercreek for the purchase of highway rock salt.

Section 2) That costs will be paid by the Engineer's Auto & Gas Tax Fund.
