

Resolution allowing the Law Library to enter into contract with Matthew Bender, a branch of Lexis Nexis, for a selection of eBooks. (Law Library) (\$5,434.00)

WHEREAS, section 307.51 of the Ohio Revised Code establishes the Franklin County Law Library and Law Library Resources Board, which may contract with other county law library resources boards, the statewide consortium of law library resources boards, private entities, or public agencies for the provision of any services that the county law library resources board considers necessary; and

WHEREAS, section 3375.481 of the Ohio Revised Code establishes the Statewide Consortium of County Law Library Resource Boards, which is given the authority to negotiate contracts that each county law library resources board may use for purchasing or obtaining access to legal research and reference materials available in any medium; and

WHEREAS, the Statewide Consortium of County Law Library Resource Boards will provide the Franklin County Law Library access to Overdrive, the platform necessary to access eBooks; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Law Library will be responsible for the purchase of an eBook library at the cost of \$1758 for year one, \$1811 for year two, and \$1865 for year three; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the Board of Commissioners grants authority to the Franklin County Law Library to enter into a contract with Matthew Bender for a selection of eBooks.
