

Resolution authorizing a settlement to Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA) for a disputed vehicle damage claim due to an auto accident involving a Franklin County Clerk of Courts of Common Pleas Auto Title employee (Clerk of Courts) (\$50.00)

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2013, Franklin County Clerk of Courts of Common Pleas Auto Title employee, Glenn Hagan, was involved in an auto accident; and

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2013, Franklin County Clerk of Courts of Common Pleas Auto Title employee Glenn Hagan failed to stop for a red light while traveling northbound on Alum Creek Drive and struck a COTA bus traveling eastbound Refugee Road onto northbound Alum Creek Drive; and

WHEREAS, the damages to the County vehicle and COTA vehicle were minimal; and

WHEREAS, COTA made a claim for damages in the amount of fifty and 00/100 dollars (\$50.00) on May 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement fairly compensates COTA for the damages to their vehicle; and

WHEREAS, there are no bodily injury claims arising out of this accident; and

WHEREAS, by agreeing to this settlement, neither COTA, the Franklin County Commissioners, nor the Franklin County Clerk of Courts of Common Pleas admits to any negligence or liability arising out of the auto accident; and

WHEREAS, the above described claim, recommended by Franklin County Fleet Management and the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, deems it to be in the best interest of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and the Franklin County Clerk of Courts of Common Pleas to pay the vehicle claim for fifty and 00/100 dollars (\$50.00); and

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

1. That the above-referenced payment in the amount of fifty and 00/100 dollars (\$50.00) is in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners, Franklin County Clerk of Courts of Common Pleas and the Department of Fleet Management and the same is hereby approved.
2. That upon execution of a full release in favor of the Franklin County Commissioners, Department of Fleet Management and the Franklin County Clerk of Courts of Common Pleas that is satisfactory to the Prosecutor's Office; a warrant be issued payable to Central Ohio Transit Authority, and forwarded to Attn: Accounting Department, 1600 McKinley Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43222-1093 as full and final settlement of this matter.
3. The attached Purchase Order in the amount of fifty and 00/100 dollars (\$50.00) is hereby approved.
