

Resolution authorizing an Agreement between the Ohio Attorney General and the Franklin County Clerk of Courts of Common Pleas for the collection of delinquent debt.

WHEREAS, The Attorney General serves as the chief collection agent for all state agencies, boards, commissions, and universities; and

WHEREAS, under recent changes in state law, the Attorney General now can collect debt on behalf of local governments under a Local Government Collection Services program pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("O.R.C.") § 131.02; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Clerk of Courts of Common Pleas wishes to certify debt to the Ohio Attorney General collection program that it deems uncollectible after internal efforts; and

WHEREAS, there is no cost to the County to enter into this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, either party may terminate this Agreement for any reason by giving written notice, at least forty-five (45) days in advance of the date of termination; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Clerk of Courts of Common Pleas recommends the Agreement submitted by the Ohio Attorney General; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS,
FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the attached Agreement with the Ohio Attorney General is hereby approved.
