

Resolution entering into a Funding Agreement with Heritage Ohio to implement a Franklin County Downtown Revitalization Services Program

(Economic Development & Planning) (\$54,175)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title I of the Housing and Community Development Acts of 1974 and 1977, as further amended, the Subrecipient has applied for and received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for certain community development activities under the Franklin County Community Development and HOME Programs; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 567-14 the Franklin County Board of Commissioners adopted the County's 2014 Annual Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development acknowledging this community development need, fulfilling all requisite citizen participation requirements related to that plan and approving this allocation within; and

WHEREAS, this contract with Heritage Ohio will implement and provide a Downtown Revitalization Services Program ("Downtown Works") in Franklin County outside of City of Columbus; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 570.503, requires that a funding agreement be executed by the grant recipient, i.e., the Franklin County Board of Commissioners, and Heritage Ohio; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the attached Funding Agreement and purchase order in the amount of \$54,175 with Heritage Ohio to implement a Franklin County Downtown Revitalization Services Program ("Downtown Works"), are hereby approved.
