

Resolution authorizing service contract renewal with Motorola Solutions for the 800 MHz Radio Communications System (Office of Homeland Security & Justice Programs) (\$74,065.14)

WHEREAS, Franklin County owns a complex, mission critical Radio Communications System designed and purchased from Motorola, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of the existing radio system with a Project 25 standard digital radio system has commenced; and

WHEREAS, continued maintenance of the existing radio system will be necessary during the planned migration process through 2016; and

WHEREAS, the current service agreement with Motorola for the Radio Communications System expired as of December 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Motorola Solutions has met the requirements of the Franklin County Purchasing Department as a Sole Source Provider and has been approved due to system features that are proprietary in nature and unique in design; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Office of Homeland Security and Justice Programs recommend the service agreement submitted by Motorola Solutions as the best for the 800 MHz Radio Communications System, and hereby enter into an agreement through the Regional Communications Section of the Office of Homeland Security and Justice Programs; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the attached service agreement with Motorola Solutions and executed by the President of the Board of County Commissioners, in an amount not to exceed the contract amount of \$74,065.14 over a one-year period, to be paid from 2015 appropriations, is hereby approved.
