

**Resolution authorizing a settlement to Brent Conrad for a disputed vehicle damage claim due to an auto accident involving a Franklin County Sheriff's Deputy (Sheriff) (\$500)**

**WHEREAS**, on November 22, 2014, a Franklin County Sheriff's Deputy was involved in an auto accident; and

**WHEREAS**, a stopped vehicle, owned by Brent Conrad was struck in the rear by a Patrol vehicle traveling northbound on US 23; and

**WHEREAS**, both vehicles sustained damage in the accident, injuries were not reported; and

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County will pay for the property damage in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for the damages done to Brent Conrad's vehicle in the accident that occurred on November 22, 2014 and Brent Conrad has accepted contingent on approval by the Commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, the above described settlement fairly compensates Brent Conrad for the damages to his vehicle; and

**WHEREAS**, by agreeing to this settlement, neither Deputy Kenneth Upton, the Franklin County Commissioners, nor the Franklin County Sheriff's Office admits to any negligence or liability arising out of the auto accident; and

**WHEREAS**, the above described settlement, recommended by Franklin County Fleet Management and the Prosecuting Attorney's Office deems it to be in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners and the Franklin County Sheriff's Office to settle the vehicle claim for Five Hundred Dollars (\$500); and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

1. That the above-referenced settlement in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) is in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners, Franklin County Sheriff's Office, and the Department of Fleet Management and the same is hereby approved.
