

Resolution authorizing a consultant agreement with Central Ohio Trauma System (COTS) for medical surge planning through the Urban Area Security Initiative Grant (OHS&JP) (\$40,000.00)

WHEREAS, the Urban Area Security Initiative grant authorizes contracts/consultants to be paid for planning purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Homeland Security Advisory Committee has designated the Central Ohio Trauma System as a lead agency for the continued development and refinement of Medical Surge Plans; and,

WHEREAS, the Homeland Security Advisory Committee has allocated Homeland Security grant funding for the development of an occupational safety and health plan and coordination of a tabletop exercise; and

WHEREAS, the term of the contract is for the period January 1, 2015 through May 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Homeland Security Advisory Committee and the Office of Homeland Security and Justice Programs recommend the contract with the Central Ohio Trauma Systems; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Purchasing Department and Franklin County Prosecutor’s Office have reviewed the contract and found it to be acceptable as to form.

The attached purchase order and consultant agreement with Central Ohio Trauma System through the Urban Area Security Initiative Grant in an amount not to exceed the contract amount of \$40,000 is hereby approved.
