

Resolution Authorizing the Settlement of Legal Claims Brought in the Franklin County Common Pleas Court, being Case No. 14-CV-4133, known as Samantha Crisp v. Franklin County Sheriff, et al., (Sheriff) (\$9,999.00)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff's Office, the Franklin County Sheriff, Chad Thompson, Charles Williamson, Anthony Kolesar, Randy Eitel, Mary McPeek, Craig Sprang, and Ronald Dillon (in their official and individual capacities) are defendants in an employment lawsuit brought by Samantha Crisp in the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas, Case No. 14-CV-4133; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 2744.07(B)(1) the Board of Commissioners may secure releases from liability for County agencies, offices and employees with respect to any claim for loss to persons or property caused by an act or omission in connection with a governmental or proprietary function; and

WHEREAS, the parties herein wish to avoid the time and expense of litigation and have reached a resolution of the matters in dispute, pending approval of the Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the settlement, the Board hereby agrees to pay a total of \$9,999.00, which will be paid via warrant issued to Samantha Crisp; and

WHEREAS, this settlement is in no way an admission of liability on the part of Franklin County Board of Commissioners, Franklin County Sheriff's Office, or the individually named defendants; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That in accordance with the preamble, which is incorporated herein, the settlement of Franklin County Common Pleas Court Case No. 14-CV-4133 in the total amount of \$9,999.00 is hereby approved; and
2. That the execution of the attached settlement agreement is hereby approved.
