

Resolution authorizing a IV-D contract with the Franklin County Prosecutor's Office (Child Support Enforcement Agency) (\$337,269.37)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3125.14, and directives from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services, the Franklin County Child Support Enforcement Agency is authorized to enter into a written agreement with the Franklin County Prosecutor's Office to establish cooperative working relationships and specify areas of responsibility for enforcement of child support between the Agency and the Prosecutor's Office; and

WHEREAS, the IV-D Service Agreement/Contractor Contract between the Franklin County Child Support Enforcement Agency and the Franklin County Prosecutor's Office will benefit the citizens of Franklin County with efficient processing of child support cases; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the attached Contract shall commence March 1, 2015, and terminate February 28, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the maximum expenditure of funds under this Contract shall not exceed \$337,269.37; and

WHEREAS, the attached purchase order encumbrance has been pre-certified as to the availability of funds by the County Auditor for payment; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Child Support Enforcement Agency requests approval of the attached IV-D Service Agreement/Contractor Contract; now, therefore,
