

Resolution authorizing the settlement of Workers' Compensation claim against the County by James Mattox. (Benefits and Risk Management) (\$0.00)

WHEREAS, on April 4, 1987, James Mattox was involved in a work-related accident that injured claimant's lower back, spine and neck and on May 14, 1980, he was involved in a work-related accident that injured claimant's right knee and legs; both of which resulted in allowed State Fund workers' compensation claims PEL69852 and PE675828 respectively; and

WHEREAS, the claimant has negotiated a full and final administrative settlement of this claim in the amount of \$125,000.00 with the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC), of which the County will not be responsible for any of this amount and settlement has been recommended by Comp Management and by the Prosecutor with his recommendation letter on file and Mr. Mattox has accepted this offer contingent upon approval by the Board; and

WHEREAS, this administrative settlement eliminates all future liability, the above described settlement is recommended to be in the best interest of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY OHIO:

That the above-referenced administrative settlement through the Ohio BWC in the amount of \$125,000 be approved.
