

Resolution authorizing an intergovernmental agreement with the Village of Harrisburg for the purpose of expending FY 2014 Urban Area Security Initiative grant funds. (OHS&JP)

WHEREAS, the Government of the United States of America has created funding resources through the Urban Area Security Initiative to assist local agencies' ability to prepare for, respond to and recover from all hazards incidents; and

WHEREAS, the Columbus Urban Area Homeland Security Advisory Committee serves as the area working groups for oversight of homeland security grant funding and have recommended the project submitted by the listed jurisdictions for funding; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County serves as the fiscal agent for the Urban Area Security Initiative; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the Village of Harrisburg wish to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Franklin County to provide for the proper legal, audit, and fiscal controls required to expend Urban Area Security Initiative grant funds.

FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:
