

Resolution of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners to convene into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing pending or imminent court action and to prepare for, conduct, or review negotiations or bargaining sessions with public employees concerning their compensation or other terms and conditions of their employment.

**(BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, public officials are required to take official action and to conduct all deliberations upon official business only in open meetings unless the subject matter is specifically excepted by law; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 121.22 (G) of the Ohio Revised Code lists the matters exempted from open meeting requirements and authorized for discussion in Executive Session; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners from time to time has matters to discuss that are exempted from open meeting requirements; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the Franklin County Board of Commissioners convenes into Executive Session on Tuesday, June 2, 2015 for the following reasons:

- 1.) Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(3), to confer with an attorney for the public body concerning disputes involving the public body that are the subject of pending or imminent court action.
- 2.) Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(4), to prepare for, conduct, or review negotiations or bargaining sessions with public employees concerning their compensation or other terms and conditions of their employment.
