

Establishing, altering and widening of road right-of-way for traffic signal improvements at the intersection of Sunbury Road and Agler Road, the City of Columbus, Mifflin, Township, Franklin County, Ohio, declared necessary (Engineer)

WHEREAS, Section 5553.04 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that when the Board of County Commissioners is of the opinion that it will be necessary for public convenience and welfare to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten, vacate or change the direction of a public road, it shall so declare by resolution; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That it is necessary for public convenience and welfare that proceedings be initiated to establish, alter and widen road right-of-way for traffic signal improvements at the intersection of Sunbury Road, County Road 8, and Agler Road, County Road 16, the City of Columbus, Mifflin Township, Franklin County, Ohio, to variable widths upon the following described centerline:

Beginning at the intersection of Sunbury Road and Agler Road, approximately 50 feet in each direction.

Section 2) That Tuesday, July 21, 2015 at 11:00 a.m., on the line of the proposed improvement, is hereby fixed as the time and place for viewing said Sunbury Road / Agler Road Traffic Signal Improvements.

Section 3) That the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio is hereby directed to cause legal publication thereof to be made in accordance with the law.
