

Resolution authorizing the binding of excess (stop gap) coverage with Midwest Employers' Casualty Company (MECC) for Franklin County's Self-Insured Workers Compensation program. (Benefits and Risk Management) (Estimated amount not to exceed \$364,140.00)

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation has granted Franklin County self-insurance status, with an effective date of April 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, sound business practices necessitate self-insured employers carry excess (stop gap) insurance coverage for catastrophic losses; and

WHEREAS, Willis of Ohio conducted a competitive selection process to select the lowest and best carrier on behalf of Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, the Benefits and Risk Management Department recommends binding the excess coverage for the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 with Midwest Employers' Casualty Company (MECC); now, therefore,
