

Resolution authorizing non-general fund supplemental appropriations and the addition of one full-time position for the Franklin County Concealed Carry Program. (Sheriff)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office has indicated that an additional Technician in the Concealed Handgun License Fund (Fund 2096) is required to address the backlog of applications due to an increase in the number of concealed carry permits being requested; and

WHEREAS, the Concealed Carry Office researches on average 300 concealed carry jackets each day, which includes checking for warrants, law violations, convictions that would require a suspension or revocation of a concealed carry license; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office has indicated that additional appropriations are required in order to cover the costs of the required background checks; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office has requested supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$60,239.18 within the Concealed Handgun License Fund for these purposes; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

- 1. That supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$60,239.18 are hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per attached document (Journal #26):

- 2. That the addition of a new full-time Technician position within the Concealed Handgun License Fund is hereby approved. In the event that funding within the Concealed Handgun License Fund is no longer available, the position authorized by this resolution shall be eliminated.
