

Resolution for Approval of Plans and Authorization to Publically Advertise for Bids for the Construction of the Sanitary District 4 Water System Valve Replacement Project (\$1,992,778)

(Sanitary Engineering)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Department of Sanitary Engineering engaged Prime AE Group, Inc. to prepare an engineering design and contract documents for the Sanitary District 4 Water Valve Replacement Project per Resolution 647-14; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District 4 area is subject to EPA Directors Findings and Orders dated July 31, 2014 and these orders require the implementation of a Unidirectional Flushing Program to improve system water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Department of Sanitary Engineering has determined that replacement of inoperable water system valves, fire hydrants, and other related system components is necessary to fully implement the required Unidirectional Flushing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners recognizes the dire need to provide reliable and quality water to Franklin County residents in Sanitary District 4 and compliance with Ohio EPA Directors Orders; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the water valve and fire hydrant replacement design and construction will be paid from grants and loans secured from the Ohio Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, the plans and bid documents for this project have been approved by the Franklin County Department of Sanitary Engineering; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the Director of the Franklin County Department of Sanitary Engineering is authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of the Sanitary District 4 Water Valve Replacement Project and execute the project upon award to the lowest and best Bidder.
