

Resolution authorizing non-general fund supplemental appropriations and the addition of a Reentry Social Services Specialist in the Office of Homeland Security & Justice Programs. (OHS&JP)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners approved Resolution No. 0416-15 supporting the Stepping Up Initiative of the National Association of Counties, the Council of State Governments Justice Center and the American Psychiatric Foundation, to reduce the number of people with mental illnesses in jails;; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office of Homeland Security & Justice Programs has requested the addition of a Reentry Social Services Specialist in the Justice Programs Fund (Fund 2083) to support this initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Reentry Social Service Specialist will be responsible for performing assessments, orientation, treatment planning, counseling, documentation, reentry planning and referral of participants to ongoing treatment services in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office of Homeland Security & Justice Programs has requested supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$9,434.95 within the Justice Programs Fund for the addition of a Reentry Social Services Specialist; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$9,434.95 are hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per attached document (Journal #1025):
