

Resolution Authorizing the Franklin County Engineer to Renew a Contract With M. P. Dory Co. For the 2016 Traffic Signal Maintenance Program (Franklin County Engineer) – \$477,172.50

WHEREAS, the Board approved Resolution No. 888-13, awarding to M. P. Dory Co. the contract for the 2014 Traffic Signal Maintenance Program, for the amount of Five Hundred Forty Six Thousand Six Hundred Three Dollars and 55/100 (\$546,603.55); and

WHEREAS, the contract allows for a maximum of two (2) one year extensions, with the agreement of both the Contractor and the County Engineer, adjusting the pay items to reflect increases or decreases in materials, equipment and labor rates; and

WHEREAS, M. P. Dory Co. has submitted a proposal requesting a 5% increase in per unit prices of all items originally bid, for the renewal period.

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Engineer accepts this proposal and agrees to extend this contract for the period ending December 31, 2016, at a 5% increase in per unit prices as described above; this extension applies to the Base Bid only and does not include the Alternate: Winchester Pike/Watkins Road/Askins Road Traffic Signal; and

WHEREAS, A purchase order will be pre-certified by the County Auditor for the amount of \$477,172.50 for payment in 2016; and

WHEREAS, regular traffic signal maintenance is necessary to ensure the safety of the traveling public; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That the Franklin County Engineer is hereby authorized to enter into a contract renewal with M. P. Dory Co. for the 2016 Traffic Signal Maintenance Program as detailed herein, through the period ending December 31, 2016, at a cost of Four Hundred Seventy Seven Thousand One Hundred Seventy Two Dollars and 50/100 (\$477,172.50);

Section 2) That a Purchase Order will be pre-certified by the Franklin County Auditor for payment in 2016. And that the funds will be encumbered with in the Auto and Gas Tax Fund (2015).
