

Resolution approving and certifying the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services' Prevention, Retention, and Contingency Plan for the 2016-17 Biennial period (Department of Job and Family Services)

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5108.04 requires each County Department of Job and Family Services to adopt a written statement of policies governing the Prevention, Retention, and Contingency Program for the county and to update it at least every two years; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services has adopted an updated written Prevention, Retention, and Contingency Statement of Policies (PRC Plan); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5108.07, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County must certify that the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services complied with Chapter 5108. of the Ohio Revised Code in adopting its PRC Plan; and

WHEREAS, The Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services proposes the funding level allocated to the One-Time Short-Term cash assistance program category be \$2,000,000.00 in federal fiscal year 2016; and

WHEREAS, The Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services proposes to improve or expand access to resources to stabilize housing (rent and mortgage) and decrease the need for emergency shelter aid;

WHEREAS, The Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services proposes to increase supports that would help customers obtain and retain employment and divert customers from needing one-time cash assistance; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the attached PRC Plan for Franklin County is hereby approved for the 2016-17 Biennial Period and that the provisions of the Plan will be effective January 1, 2016.
2. That the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio certifies that the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services complied with Chapter 5108. of the Ohio Revised Code in adopting the statement of policies (PRC Plan).
