

Resolution proposing to cooperate with the Director of Transportation to perform a study of the SR161 corridor through Linworth, Franklin County, Ohio (Engineer)

WHEREAS, the State has identified a need for the following described project:

This project proposes to perform a study of the SR161 corridor through Linworth. Potential improvements to be studied include a grade separation with the railroad, roadway widening, pedestrian and bikeway facilities and various safety improvements; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That Franklin County gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

Section 2) That Franklin County shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

Franklin County hereby agrees to cooperate with the Director of Transportation of the State of Ohio in the planning of the identified highway improvement project and grants consent to the Ohio Department of Transportation for its development of the project;

The Ohio Department of Transportation shall assume and bear one hundred percent of the necessary costs of the State's highway improvement project; the County's share of the cost for the study is estimated to be \$15,000.00.

Franklin County agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the total cost of those features requested by the County which are not necessary for the improvement as determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration.

Section 3) That funds for payment be encumbered within the Motor Vehicle License & Gasoline Tax Fund (2015).

Section 4) That the Franklin County Engineer is hereby empowered on behalf of Franklin County to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation and other governmental agencies as necessary to complete the above described project.
