

**Resolution authorizing the County Administrator to enter into an agreement with the City of Columbus to share in the annual service and hardware cost of replacing the current Automated Fingerprint Identification System.
(Commissioners)**

WHEREAS, the County utilizes the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) operated by the City of Columbus; and

WHEREAS, the current AFIS system is over 15 years old, and is near full capacity and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the AFIS upgrade will be \$10.6 million over an eleven year period, with the first year cost of \$991,703; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the AFIS upgrade will be split evenly between the City of Columbus and Franklin County, less the amount of any other offsetting revenue; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the County Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Columbus to share in the annual service and hardware cost of replacing the current Automated Fingerprint Identification System.
2. That a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$495,851.50 is hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #2747):
