

**Resolution authorizing a water tap permit in support of a public park near Village Park subdivision**

**(Sanitary Engineering)**

**WHEREAS**, Prairie Township Board of Trustees, Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio, owns Parcel ID 010-258012, property within the municipal boundaries of the City of Columbus and near the Village Park Subdivision; and

**WHEREAS**, Prairie Township Board of Trustees proposes to build a public park on Parcel ID 010-258012; and

**WHEREAS**, Prairie Township Board of Trustees desires to provide water for their proposed public park, and via their engineer have requested to tap into a water main owned, operated and maintained by the Franklin County Board of Commissioners that traverses the same parcel ; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners own, operate and maintain a water utility, in certain unincorporated areas of Franklin County, including the Village Park Subdivision, as per an agreement per Resolution 0846-12 (December 11, 2012), and executed by the City of Columbus, March 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Department of Sanitary Engineering has determined that the water service for the project as proposed by Prairie Township will not limit the capacity for water services to the Village Park Subdivision; and, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The Director of the Franklin County Department of Sanitary Engineering is hereby authorized to send the attached letter, as reviewed by the Franklin County Prosecutor's Office, to Columbus Public Utilities, Division of Power and Water, on behalf of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners, allowing for the water tap permit.
