

Establishing, altering and widening of Norton Road, County Road No. 3, at Johnson Road, Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio, declared necessary (Engineer)

WHEREAS, Section 5553.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, provided that when the Board of County Commissioners is of the opinion that it will be necessary for public convenience and welfare to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten, vacate or change the direction of a public road, it shall so declare by resolution; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That it is necessary for public convenience and welfare that proceedings be initiated to establish, alter and widen Norton Road, County Road No. 3, at Johnson Road, Prairie Township, Franklin County, Ohio, to variable widths upon the following described centerline:

Beginning at the intersection of Norton Road and Johnson Road for approximately 850 feet in each direction.

Section 2) That Tuesday, March 29, 2016 at 11:00 a.m., on the line of the proposed improvement, is hereby fixed as the time and place for viewing said Norton Road at Johnson Road project.

Section 3) That the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio is hereby directed to cause legal publication thereof to be made in accordance with the law.
