

Resolution designating the lead agency for the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program (CCMEP)

(COMMISSIONERS)

WHEREAS, Section 305.190 of the Amended Substitute House Bill 64 of the 131st General Assembly, the state's biennial budget, creates the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program to provide employment, training and other supportive services to mandatory and voluntary program participants ages 16 to 24 based upon a comprehensive assessment of an individual's employment and training needs; and

WHEREAS, each Board of County Commissioners are required by law to, no later than May 15, 2016, designate either the county department of job and family services or the local workforce development agency that serves the county as the lead agency responsible for administering the program and meeting performance goals established by the state; and

WHEREAS, the effective date for the implementation of the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program shall be July 1, 2016.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services shall be the lead agency responsible for administering the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program (CCMEP) effective July 1, 2016.
