

Resolution authorizing a novation agreement with Eckerd Youth Alternatives, Inc. (Department of Job and Family Services)

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2015 Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services and Henkels and McCoy entered into a subaward agreement for the provision of youth afterschool programming for TANF eligible high school students (Resolution #00592-15) for the period beginning September 8, 2015 through June 12, 2016; and

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2016 Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services was notified that Henkels and McCoy was donating its unincorporated Training Services Group division to Eckerd Youth Alternatives, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Eckerd Youth Alternatives a nonprofit corporation located at 100 North Starcrest Drive, Clearwater, Florida 33765 founded in 1968 has given much needed second chances to more than 168,000 children and families throughout the US; and

WHEREAS, effective immediately and by signing this Novation Agreement, Eckerd Youth Alternatives, Inc. agrees to assume liability of the original agreement between Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services and Henkels and McCoy and agrees to continue to provide youth afterschool programming for TANF eligible high school students with the same terms and conditions as set forth in the original agreement; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons cited above, and in consideration of the mutual covenants herein, the parties agree that Eckerd Youth Alternatives, Inc. shall perform all of the contractual obligations agreed to by Henkels and McCoy in the original subaward agreement in every way as if they were an original party thereto; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the attached novation agreement is hereby approved.
