

Resolution authorizing a non-general fund supplemental appropriation for the Justice Assistance Grant program. (Office of Homeland Security & Justice Programs)

WHEREAS, Franklin County serves as the Metropolitan County Criminal Justice Services Agency in accordance with Sections 5502.64 and 5502.65 of the Ohio Revised Code under the direction of the existing Franklin County Criminal Justice Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Homeland Security and Justice Programs serves as the fiscal agent for the joint funds awarded to Franklin County, the City of Columbus, and the City of Whitehall for the FY2015 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the FY2015 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Funds will be used to support a range of law enforcement projects for the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office, the Whitehall Police Department, and the Columbus Division of Police; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Homeland Security & Justice Programs has requested a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$481,596 within the Justice Assistance Grant Fund (Fund 2127) to support these law enforcement projects; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$481,596 is hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #34):
