

Resolution authorizing a First Amendment to the In Building Radio Distribution Agreement with NEW PAR d/b/a Verizon Wireless, allowing for an upgrade of an In Building Radio System deployed in the Franklin County Judicial Services Building. (Public Facilities Management)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio ("County") wishes to offer an optimal reception environment for users of cell phones in its facilities, including the Franklin County Common Pleas Courthouse ("FCCH"), located at 345 South High Street, Columbus, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the County and NEW Par d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Verizon"), a provider of cell phone services agreed to enter into an In Building Radio Distribution System Agreement ("Agreement") to install an In Building Radio Distribution System ("IBRD System") in the FCCH to enhance its level of customer service; and

WHEREAS, the County and Verizon now wish to enter into a First Amendment to the Agreement and allow Verizon to upgrade the existing IBRD System in the FCCH; and

WHEREAS, the design, construction, equipment, installation and maintenance for the upgrade of the IBRD System shall be at Verizon's expense; and

WHEREAS, the First Amendment to the Amendment executed by the County and Verizon shall be the governing contract which is fully incorporated herein, and is binding on both parties; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Facilities Management recommends the approval of the First Amendment to the In Building Radio Distribution Agreement with Verizon to upgrade the IRBD System in the FCCH; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

That the attached First Amendment to the In Building Radio Distribution Agreement with New Par d/b/a Verizon Wireless is hereby approved.
