

Resolution authorizing a one-year contract with the Healthcare Collaborative of Greater Columbus for access to strengthen the delivery of primary health care through service coordination. (Community Partnerships) (\$25,000)

WHEREAS, the fragmentation of our delivery system is a fundamental contributor to the poor overall performance of the U.S. health care system; and

WHEREAS, such fragmentation leads to patients navigating unassisted across different providers and care settings, fostering frustrating and uncoordinated care that can put patient's health at risk; and

WHEREAS, The Healthcare Collaborative of Greater Columbus is a community-based nonprofit, public-private partnership working to improve access to health care by coordinating health care delivery improvement projects in central Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commissioners, in recognition of the benefits to the citizens of Franklin County, desire to participate in this planning and assist in establishing and operating programs to assure the health and well-being of citizens of Franklin County Ohio pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3709.283; now, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

That the attached contract for services with the Healthcare Collaborative of Greater Columbus for the period of January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016 and the attached purchase order, individually described on the accompanying Purchase Order Proof List in an amount not to exceed \$25,000, are hereby approved.
