

Resolution authorizing the Subgrant Agreement between the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services and the Franklin County Child Support Enforcement Agency for the program known as the Access & Visitation Program (Franklin County Child Support Enforcement Agency) (\$35,000.00)

WHEREAS, the subgrant is made pursuant to the federal award of Grants to States for Access and Visitation Programs, CFDA number 93.597, award number 2012G9912AV, award year 2012, which was awarded by the United States Department of Health and Human Services, pursuant to Section 469B of the Social Security Act; and

WHEREAS, the services provided under this agreement are authorized by the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996, 42 USC 669b; and

WHEREAS, ODJFS issued a Request for Application (RFA) titled, "Access and Visitation Services," numbered R-1213-09-8032, and dated April 18, 2011, which is hereby incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the ODJFS awarded the Franklin County CSEA a grant for the provision of Access and Visitation Services (G-1213-09-0601) in accordance with the application and subgrant agreement approved by Resolution 747-12; and

WHEREAS, the first subgrant agreement under this grant was effective October 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 and the current subgrant agreement will be in effect from October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2017, unless the Agreement is suspended or terminated pursuant to Article V, prior to the above termination date and upon satisfactory completion of activities hereunder, appropriation of funds by the Ohio General Assembly, and at the sole discretion of ODJFS; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of this subgrant is thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00); and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that four (4) more subgrant agreements will be required at the end of each state fiscal year until June 30, 2020 when the grant ends; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the attached Subgrant Agreement with Ohio Department of Job and Family Services is hereby approved in the amount of \$35,000.00.

That the Director of the Franklin County Child Support Enforcement Agency is hereby authorized to execute this sub-grant agreement and any future subgrant agreements relating to the Access Visitation Program consistent with this resolution.
