

**Resolution authorizing a non-general fund supplemental appropriation to promote the Alert Franklin County mass notification system.  
(Emergency Management Agency)**

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County Emergency Management & Homeland Security purchased a subscription in 2015 for a county-wide mass notification system that was branded as Alert Franklin County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alert Franklin County system was made available in July 2015 for the public to enroll in order to receive both jurisdictional and county-wide alerts; and

**WHEREAS**, there are currently 6,510 registered users registered in the system, which seriously under-utilizes one of the main functions of Alert Franklin County; and

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County Emergency Management & Homeland Security is requesting supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$27,075 to hire a marketing firm to help promote the Alert Franklin County system; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$27,075 is hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #414):
