

**Resolution to designate necessary signs be erected in order to allow parking on the south side of Kinnear Road between Hess Boulevard and Rhoda Avenue. (Engineer)**

**WHEREAS**, on December 20, 1988, the Board approved Resolution No. 1545-88 prohibiting parking or stopping of vehicles on both sides of Kinnear Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Engineer has received requests from Clinton Township that regulations be adopted for the safety and convenience of the traveling public allowing parking on Kinnear Road between Hess Boulevard and Rhoda Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Engineer, after an investigation of the traffic and parking conditions at these locations recommends that vehicles be allowed to park on the south side of Kinnear Road between Hess Boulevard and Rhoda Avenue; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That pursuant to the provisions of the Uniform Traffic Act, Section 4511.07 et seq., Ohio Revised Code, the Franklin County Engineer is hereby authorized to post necessary signs allowing parking on the south side of Kinnear Road from Hess Boulevard to Rhoda Avenue.
