

Resolution authorizing an amendment to the sub grant agreement with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for the providing of funds allocated by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.

**(COMMISSIONERS)**

**WHEREAS**, there exists a memorandum of understanding between the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and the City of Columbus (as Chief Elected Officials), and the Central Ohio Workforce Investment Corporation (as the Local Workforce Development Board and Fiscal Agent), for the delivery of program and services associated with local workforce development activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) receives a grant award from the federal government for funds for workforce development activities pursuant to the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA); and

**WHEREAS**, ODJFS serves as the “pass-through entity” to local area sub grantees to provide funding for such services, pursuant to WIOA; and

**WHEREAS**, the most recent sub grant agreement was authorized by the Franklin County Commissioners by approval of Resolution 664-15, passed September 1, 2015, establishing the terms and conditions of the local area’s receipt of WIOA funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the term of that agreement was shortened to one year, expiring June 30, 2016, to reflect the transition and implementation of the new WIOA legislation; and

**WHEREAS**, the agreement must now be amended to reflect the full term of the agreement through June 30, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, other important changes must be made to the agreement, such as the designation of the certified local area Workforce Development Board to serve as the Fiscal Agent for purposes under this agreement, in order to meet the terms of the WIOA legislation; and

**WHEREAS**, signatures to amend the agreement must include the Chief Elected Officials, authorized representatives of the Local Workforce Development Board and the Fiscal Agent; now, therefore,
