

Resolution authorizing the Franklin County Board of Commissioners to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the city of Columbus to administer the FY 2016 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). (OHS&JP)

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance has authorized funding through the FY16 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) for multiple purposes including enhancing local crime prevention and education initiatives and law enforcement training and response; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance has designated funding to the city of Columbus under the FY 2016 Justice Assistance Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Justice Assistance has declared a disparate allocation status exists that requires an Memorandum of Understanding between Franklin County and the city of Columbus detailing the funding allocation and administration of the award prior to final application and acceptance of the award; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS,
FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The Franklin County Commissioners are authorized to enter into an MOU with the city of Columbus to apply for, accept and administer the FY 2016 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).
