

Resolution authorizing a settlement to Vadim Chmil for a disputed property damage claim due to an auto accident involving a Franklin County Sheriff's Deputy (Sheriff) (\$500.00)

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2016 Franklin County Sheriff Deputy Richard Coyne was involved in an auto accident; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Coyne backed his vehicle into the front passenger side corner of Mr. Vadim Chmil's vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Chmil has provided his insurance information showing his Five Hundred Dollar (\$500.00) deductible and two estimates of damage repair; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County will pay for the deductible of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to cover the property damages to Vadim Chmil's vehicle for the accident that occurred on July 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement fairly compensates Vadim Chmil for the damages to her vehicle; and

WHEREAS, by agreeing to this settlement, neither Deputy Richard Coyne, the Franklin County Commissioners, nor the Franklin County Sheriff's Office admits to any negligence or liability arising out of the auto accident; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement, recommended by Franklin County Fleet Management and the Prosecuting Attorney's Office deems it to be in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners and the Franklin County Sheriff's Office to settle the property damage claim deductible in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

1. That the above-referenced settlement in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) is in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners, Franklin County Sheriff's Office, and the Department of Fleet Management and the same is hereby approved.
