

Resolution authorizing a settlement to Mr. Kim Sweet for a disputed vehicle damage claim due to an auto accident involving a Franklin County Dog Shelter's Warden (Dog Shelter & Adoption Center) (\$667.36)

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2016, Franklin County Dog Shelter Warden, Anthony Harris, was involved in an auto accident; and

WHEREAS, Warden Harris was driving county vehicle #287 in the parking lot of 911 Stelzer Road; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kim Sweet, owner of a Nissan truck, was parked in the lot at 911 Stelzer Road, Officer Harris was backing and struck Mr. Sweet's vehicle;

WHEREAS, Mr. Sweet's vehicle sustained damage in the accident, and was unoccupied; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County will pay the damages of six hundred sixty-seven and 36/100 dollars (\$667.36) as allowed by the Ohio Revised Code to Mr. Kim Sweet for damages to his vehicle in the accident that occurred on July 11, 2016; and Mr. Sweet has accepted contingent on approval by the Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement fairly compensates Kim Sweet for the damages to his vehicle; and

WHEREAS, by agreeing to this settlement, neither Anthony Harris, the Franklin County Commissioners, nor the Franklin County Dog Shelter's Office admits to any negligence or liability out of the auto accident; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement, recommended by Franklin County Fleet Management, and the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, deems it to be in the best interest of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and the Franklin County Dog Shelter's Office to settle the vehicle claim for six hundred sixty-seven and 36/100 dollars (\$667.36); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the above-referenced settlement in the amount of six hundred sixty-seven and 36/100 dollars (\$667.36) is in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners, Franklin County Dog Shelter & Adoption Center's Office and the Department of Fleet Management and the same is hereby approved.
2. That upon execution of a full release in favor of the Franklin County Commissioners, Department of Fleet Management and the Franklin Dog Shelter and Adoption Center's Office that is satisfactory to the Prosecutor's Office; a warrant be issued payable to Kim Sweet, and forwarded to 2681 Maplewood Drive, Columbus, Ohio 43231 as full and final settlement of this matter.
3. That the attached Purchase Order in the amount of six hundred sixty-seven and 36/100 dollars (\$667.36) is approved.
