

Resolution authorizing the Franklin County Community Funding Initiative supported by funding from the American Rescue Plan Act. (Community Partnerships) (\$5,000,000)

WHEREAS, the President of the United States issued a Nationwide Emergency Declaration for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) on March 13, 2020 pursuant to sections 201 and 301 of the National Emergencies Act (50 U.S.C. 1601 et seq.) and consistent with section 1135 of the Social Security Act (SSA), as amended (42 U.S.C. 1320b-5); and

WHEREAS, Title IX of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (H.R. 1319) authorized the creation of a Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to make payments to units of local government that are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners approved Resolution No. 0181-20 on March 12, 2020 authorizing actions to be taken to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Franklin County from the effects of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Community Funding Initiative was created to assist nonprofit organizations in Franklin County that are serving residents hardest hit by the COVID-19 pandemic; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the County Administrator is hereby authorized pursuant to section 305.30 of the Revised Code to sign any documents associated with the Franklin County Community Funding Initiative.
2. That the attached purchase orders totaling \$5,000,000 that are individually described on the accompanying Auditor's Certificate are hereby approved.

3. That a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$5,000,000 is hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #758):
