

Resolution approving a COVID-19 Recovery Grant subaward amendment with the Columbus Urban League for the Building and Driving Futures Workforce Training Program (an increase of \$923,100) (Department of Job and Family Services) (\$3,173,100)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services is authorized to enter into subaward agreements with public and private organizations for the purchase of TANF, Title XX, CCMEP, General Revenue Fund, and U.S Department of Treasury Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds authorized in section 9901 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 services pursuant to the Ohio Administrative Code and rules promulgated by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services; and

WHEREAS, Title IX of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (H.R. 1319) authorized the creation of a Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to make payments to units of local government that are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, assistance to individuals who want and are available for work is an eligible use of funds pursuant to §35.6(b)(3)(ii)(A)(8) of the Final Rule promulgated by the U.S. Department of Treasury; and

WHEREAS, Resolution Number 0783-20 authorized Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services to enter into a subaward agreement with the Columbus Urban League for the Building and Driving Futures workforce training program in the amount of \$850,000, for the time period of October 1, 2020, through September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Resolution Number 0760-21 authorized Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services to amend the terms of the subaward agreement with Columbus Urban League, by adding \$1,400,000 to the original subaward amount of \$850,000, for an amended total dollar value of \$2,250,000, and extending the expiration date from September 30, 2021 to September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree to further amend the terms of the subaward agreement with Columbus Urban League, by adding \$923,100 in COVID-19 Recovery Grant funds to the current subaward amount of \$2,250,000, for an amended total dollar value of \$3,173,100. The
