

Resolution authorizing a one-year Software as a Service agreement with Cordico, Inc. (Sheriff) (\$49,929.26)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff's Office wishes to offer a mobile wellness app to its deputies that is geared toward supporting first responder mental and physical health; and

WHEREAS Ohio Revised Code § 9.48 authorizes the County's use of joint purchasing programs and, therefore, allows for the County's procurement of the CordicoShield mobile app solution through Insight Public Sector, Inc. under Omnia Partners Contract #4400006644; and

WHEREAS \$3,429.26 of the \$49,929.26 is an administrative fee for utilization of the cooperative contract; and

WHEREAS, Data Board #22-001-20225249 issued on January 10, 2022 approved the CordicoShield mobile app project; and

WHEREAS, the Software as a Service Agreement will be in effect from September 13, 2022, for a period of one (1) year; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff's Office recommends that the Board of Commissioners approve the Software as a Service Agreement with Cordico, Inc. now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the attached Software as a Service Agreement with Cordico Inc., is hereby approved.
2. The attached PO in the amount of Forty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars and Twenty-Six Cents (\$49,929.26) made payable to Insight Public Sector Inc. is hereby approved.
3. The Franklin County Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Administrator pursuant to section 305.30 of the Ohio Revised Code to sign the Software as a Service agreement with Cordico Inc. and sign the required Apple applicant authority letter to create an Apple developer account and accept the Apple Developer Agreement terms electronically.

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4. That the County Administrator is hereby authorized to take any and all actions necessary including execution of additional documents that are not in conflict with this Resolution.
