

Resolution authorizing a grant agreement with The Ohio State University Foundation that will provide services and programming to promote and support access to the Social Determinants of Health for seniors in Franklin County. (Office on Aging) (\$75,000.00)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office on Aging administers Franklin County Senior Options, which provides services for the elderly; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office on Aging annually awards grant funds to non-profit organizations to expand community services for the elderly population of Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office on Aging desires to provide Senior Services Levy Funds to The Ohio State University Foundation, for the Pair 2 Care Program that provides support of dementia family caregivers in Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, The Pair 2 Care Program will support dementia family caregivers enrolled within Franklin County, Ohio, by helping address anxiety, depressive symptoms, caregiver burden, social support and loneliness while improving quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the grant aligns with the Franklin County Rise Together Blueprint for Reducing Poverty in Franklin County Ohio, the Social Determinants of Health and supports improved health outcomes for residents living with chronic, mental, physical and behavioral health conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners' Initiative to Promote Health Equity aligns with the goal of improving physical, mental and behavioral health and well-being by increasing access to care, utilization of services and social connectedness; now, therefore,

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That upon approval to form by the Franklin County Prosecutor's Office, the agreement with The Ohio State University Foundation is hereby approved.
2. That the attached purchase orders in the total amount of \$75,000.00 that is individually described on the accompanying Purchase Order Proof List is hereby approved.
3. That the Board of Commissioners is hereby authorized to take all actions, including the execution of all documents or amendments upon approval to form by the Franklin County Prosecutor's Office, necessary to enter into, implement, and administer the contracts and that are not substantially inconsistent with this Resolution
